September 8 - 17, 2025

10 Days / 9 Nights

Day #1 – Monday, September 8th:

5:15 AM	Depart Urbana from Peoria Charter, 1910 N Federal Road
6:15 AM	Depart Normal from Schnuck's off Raab Road, 1750 Bradford Lane
7:00 AM	Depart Morton from Wal Mart, 155 E Courtland St., (behind Culvers)
7:45 AM	Depart Peoria from Peoria Charter Waiting Room, 2600 NE Adams Street
	traveling west to our overnight destination – Lincoln, Nebraska! We'll make rest
	& meal stops along the way as needed.
5:30 PM	Arriving in Lincoln, we check into our hotel and freshen up before heading out
	for dinner.
6:30 PM	Dinner is on your own this evening.

Day #2 – Tuesday, September 9th:

Breakfast* is included this morning at the hotel before we check out and depart for Colorado.

8:00 AM We check out and depart for another travel day to get to our destination — Colorado. We'll make rest and meal stops along the way. Note: Don't forget to set your watches back 2 hours as we enter the Mountain Time Zone.

4:30 PM We arrive in the Denver area at **Drury Inn*** for the next 2 nights. Enjoy Drury's "Kickback Program" for dinner. You'll enjoy selections like Chicken Tenders, baked potatoes, buffalo style wings, charbroiled meatballs, fresh carrots, celery, egg rolls, garden salad, hot dogs, soup and more. Afterward, head to your room to relax after a long travel day.

Day #3 – Wednesday, September 10th:

Breakfast* is served at the hotel.

8:00 AM We depart for Georgetown for your first train ride on the Georgetown Scenic

Peoria Charter Travel 6035 Knoxville Avenue, Suite 101-B Peoria, IL 61614 (309) 688-9523, Ext. 130 **Railroad*.** An old-time steam locomotive chugging its way up the canyon, hauling your train past the remains of several gold & silver mines. This open car train takes you between Georgetown and silver Plume, over 2 miles apart, over mountainous terrain, requiring trestles, cuts, fills, loops, and curves totaling 3.1 miles of narrow-gauge track. (10:00-11:30 AM Reservation)

12:30 PM Lunch on your own After lunch we mee

After lunch we meet our **Local Guide for** an afternoon tour of **Denver***. Denver is both an old cowboy town and a very modern city now with seven major professional sports teams. On our tour, you'll visit old historic Denver as well as the newer part of Denver. (2:00 – 4:00 **PM Tour**)

4:30 PM Tonight, you are free to do as you please. Dinner is on your own, but you may wish to take advantage of the 5:30 Kickback at the hotel as the foods are rotating.

Day #4 – Thursday, September 11th:

Breakfast* is included again this morning

6:00 AM We check out and depart for Amtrak's California Zephyr Denver to Grand Junction*.

8:05 AM This morning we board the California Zephyr for an all-day excursion to Grand Junction, Colorado. Travel the Rocky Mountains passing through canyons only accessible by train. And finally, on to Grand Junction where awe-inspiring natural beauty welcomes you at every turn. Lunch will be on your own as the train will stop for lunch. We arrive in Grand Junction at approximately 4:00 PM.

4:30 PM We check into our Grand Junction hotel for an overnight stay. **Dinner*** is included this evening at **Famous Dave's BBQ.** Treat yourself to authentic, pitsmoked BBQ, made-from-scratch sides, and handcrafted desserts.

8:30 PM Following dinner, you can rest in your hotel to get ready for another busy day tomorrow.

Day #5 – Friday, September 12th: Breakfast* is served here at the hotel this morning.
 7:45 AM We check out and head out for our 3-hour Jeep Tour*.



10:00 AM This tour is over 12,000 feet at Corkscrew Pass and into the Red Mountains. You ride beside high mountain cliffs over hanging mining trails where the clear air and the color of the red mountains is simply astonishing. The jeep tour ends in Historic Silverton with a Box Lunch*.
2:45 PM We board train #2 – the Silverton-Durango Railroad*. This steam locomotive travels along the Animas River winding through spectacular

and breathtaking canyons in the remote wilderness of San Juan National Forest. You may feel as though you are reliving history as you travel on the same tracks that miners, cowboys, and settlers of the Old West took over a century ago. Following the train ride, we check into our Durango area hotel for the night. Your hotel is close to all the adventure and located on main Avenue just minutes from historic downtown Durango. The railroad is a short distance away and you are two blocks from access to The Animas River Trail. *Note: Please dress in layers as you travel through the San Juan Mountains**.

6:30 PM Dinner* is included at Gazpacho Restaurant*.8:00 PM We check into our Durango hotel for the night.

Day #6 – Saturday, September 13th:

Breakfast* is included this morning.

6:00 AM Early this morning you travel to Chama, New Mexico for a ride on train #3 – The **Cumbres & Toltec Railroad*.**

10:00 AM Perhaps the most beautiful ride in America, it is rugged, narrow-gauge, coal-fired, steam-powered mountain railroad traversing 64 miles of unparalleled scenery. You'll climb through an unspoiled landscape, past historic railroad structures dating back to the turn-of-the-twentieth century. Enjoy the grandeur of the Rocky Mounts as this sure-footed locomotive roll through tunnels, above deep gorges and over Cumbres Pass. A stop is made for an included **Lunch*** at the lonely Osier Dining Hall near the halfway point.

5:45 PM After the train ride, we drop the luggage at our hotel in Alamosa, Colorado for the night. Then depart for dinner.

6:30 PM Dinner* is included this evening at the **San Luis Valley Brewing Co.**

8:30 PM The rest of the evening is free to relax and prepare for tomorrow's adventure.

Day #7 – Sunday, September 14th:

Breakfast* is served at the hotel.

8:30 AM We depart for the Royal Gorge Train.

12:30 PM Today you'll ride the Royal Gorge Train* for a scenic journey through the spectacular Royal Gorge. Since 1879, these tracks have followed the winding, tumbling Arkansas River deep within the soaring, 1,000-foot granite cliffs of Colorado's Royal Gorge. The Royal Gorge Route is a quality, Colorado attraction – no thrill rides or cotton candy – just rugged scenery. This ride also includes a delicious Lunch*.

4:00 PM This afternoon, **tour the Garden of the Gods Park***, a Registered National Natural Landmark in Colorado Springs. Learn of the park's geology with the 14-minute movie, and experience Native-American culture.

6:30 PM Dinner* is at the **Edelweiss Restaurant.** For 30 years, this family spot has offered authentic German cuisine in a cozy Bavarian setting.

Day #8 – Monday, September 15th:

Breakfast* is served at the hotel

8:30 AM We depart to tour* the Manitou Cliff Dwellings.

9:00 AM The dwellings are located at the foot of Pikes Peak. Authentic Anasazi cliff dwellings, built more than 700 years ago, await you here. These mountain dwellings are a rare historical treasure and depict the lives, culture and architectural achievements of Southwestern Native Americans. There are no "Do Not Touch" signs. You are free to touch and even go inside these fascinating architectural remnants of an American Indian Culture that roamed the Four Corners area of the Southwest from 1200 B.C. to A.D. 1300.

11:15 AM Lunch is on your own in Manitou Springs.

We depart for a **ride on the Pikes Peak Cog Railway*.** New trains, new depot, new Summit Visitor Center, new track, and one of the most unique experiences in the world. It's historic: we've been climbing to the top of Pikes Peak since 1891. It's emotionally moving: this place inspired "America the Beautiful", written by



Katharine Lee Bates, whose experience in 1893 on top of Pikes Peak moved her to pen the poem that became one of the most patriotic songs honoring America. We take you to the top of Pikes Peak, America's Mountain, but this journey is so much more than that it's a lifetime experience.

5:30 PM Tonight Dinner* is included at the Flying W Ranch. Enjoy a real Chuckwagon Dinner and be entertained by the Flying W Wranglers. The Wranglers specialize in beautiful 3-part vocal harmonies about the romantic American Cowboy.

Day #9 – Tuesday, September 16th:

Breakfast* is included this morning before we check out and begin our journey towards home.

8:00 AM We check out, board our coach and depart for our overnight stop in Junction City, Kansas. We'll make rest and meal stops along the way as needed. *Note: Don't forget to forward your watches an hour as we re-enter the Central Time Zone.*

5:45 PM We arrive in Junction City and drop the bags at our hotel before heading to dinner.

6:30 PM Dinner* is included this evening at **Cracker Barrel.**

Day #10 – Wednesday, September 17th:

Breakfast* is served before we check out.

8:00 AM We check out and depart for the final leg of our journey home. We'll make rest and meal stops along the way as needed.

6:00 PM Approximate arrival time back in Peoria.

7:15 PM Approximate arrival time back in Normal.8:15 PM Approximate arrival time back in Urbana.
