

# Colonial Williamsburg Grand Illumination

December 11 - 16, 2025

6 Days / 5 Nights

## Day #1 – Thursday, December 11th:

**6:15 AM** Depart Peoria from 2600 NE Adams Street.

**6:40 AM** Depart Morton from Wal Mart, 155 E Courtland Street (behind Culvers)

**7:15 AM** Depart Normal from Schnuck's off Raab Road, 1750 Bradford Lane. We'll make

a ½ hour break stop in LeRoy before picking up our Urbana passengers.

**8:45** AM Depart Urbana from Peoria Charter, 1910 N Federal Drive traveling east to

Chillicothe, Ohio to our home for the night. Note: Don't forget to set your

watches ahead an hour as we enter the Eastern Time Zone.

5:00 PM We check into the **Hampton Inn & Suites\*** and have time to freshen up before

dinner.

**6:00 PM Dinner\*** is included at a local restaurant.

# Day #2 – Friday, December 12th:

**7:00 AM** We check out, board our coach and depart for a stop in Richmond, Virginia. We'll

make rest & meal stops along the way.

**4:00 PM** We arrive at **Historic St. John's Church\***. We meet our **Step-on Guide\*** who

will be with us the entire weekend. At the church you'll enjoy a rare re-enactment of Patrick Henry's famous speech. As tensions grew between the colonies and Great Britain in the 1770's, Virginia held a series of meetings to organize its protests against the mother country. In March of 1775, the Second Virginia Convention was held here at what was then called Henrico Parish Church. Patrick

Henry, George Washington, Thomas Jefferson, Peyton Randolph and other prominent Virginians were delegates to the convention. Here, Patrick Henry embodied the spirit of the Revolution on March 23, 1775 with his words, "Give

Me Liberty ..... or give me Death".

**5:00 PM** Following our visit, we depart for our hotel in Williamsburg, Virginia.

**6:00 PM** We check into the **Embassy Suites\*** and enjoy the **Manager's Reception.**

**2:00 PM Lunch\*** is included at Rocco's Smokehouse and is a southern buffet.

**3:00 PM** Return to the hotel to relax before our evening festivities

5:00 PM Depart for Colonial Williamsburg where we'll enjoy the **Grand Illumination**Festivities with Fireworks at the Governor's Palace @ 7:00 PM. The Grand Illumination is an adaptation of a common practice during the 18th century when ordinary citizens celebrated extraordinary events – major military victories, the arrival of a new colonial governor or the birthday of the monarch – by firing guns and using fireworks. The festivities begin with a variety of traditional holiday

entertainment – Fifes & Drums provide 18th Century holiday music, balladeers

and musicians perform, church choirs sing Christmas carols and costumed performers' present entertainment found in Williamsburg 200 years ago. As the evening progresses a magnificent fireworks display takes place simultaneously at three locations in the Historic Area – Palace Green, the Magazine, and the Capitol.

Candles are then lit in the public buildings, shops and throughout Colonial Williamsburg's Historic Area.

# Day #4 – Sunday, December 14<sup>th</sup>:

9:30 AM Our guide takes us on a Guided Tour of Jamestown Settlement\*. "A Colonial Christmas" offers a glimpse of 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup>-century holiday traditions. Little is known about Christmases at Jamestown, but it is likely there were few celebrations other than church services to mark the holiday. "A Jamestown Christmas" holiday film and special interpretive programs compare and contrast English Christmas customs of the period with how the season may have been observed in the difficult early years of America's first permanent English colony. In England, the holiday season – extending from December 25 – January 6 – was

a time of merriment and feasting. Lunch will be on your own today at Jamestown Café.

**1:00 PM** Load the coach and depart for Yorktown, Virginia!

1:30 PM Next we enjoy a guided tour of the American Revolution Museum at



Yorktown\*. Gain a new appreciation and understanding of our nation's beginnings at the American Revolution Center where America's evolution from colonial status to nationhood is chronicled through a unique blend of timeline, thematic exhibits and outdoor living history areas that emphasizes the experiences of ordinary the experiences of ordinary people. In an outdoor recreated Continental Army encampment, historical interpreters depict the daily life of a soldier and a recreated 1780's farm provides a look at how many Americans lived in the early years of our nation.

**3:30 PM** It's time to board our coach and depart for Norfolk, Virginia!

**5:00 PM** Winterfest on the Wisconsin\*. Enjoy the holiday season with nightly entertainment, illuminations, and seasonal treats! Featuring more than one million festive lights aboard the Historic Battleship Wisconsin and the Mistletoe Marina.

**6:30 PM Dinner\*** is included.

**8:00 PM** Approximate return time to the hotel for the evening.
