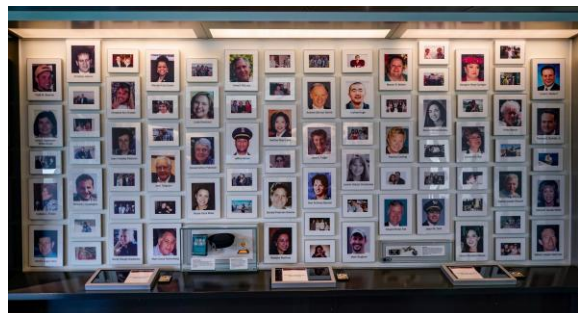
7 Days / 6 Nights

Day #1 – Monday, May 18th:

- 6:00 AM** Depart Peoria Charter from 2600 NE Adams Street
- 6:25 AM** Depart Morton from Wal Mart, 155 E Courtland Street, behind Culvers
- 7:00 AM** Depart Normal from Schnuck's off Raab Road, 1750 Bradford Lane. We'll make a 20-minute rest area stop before picking up in Urbana.
- 8:45 AM** Depart Urbana from Peoria Charter, 1910 N Federal Drive traveling southeast towards our first stop. *Note: Don't forget to set your watches ahead an hour as we enter the Eastern Time Zone.*
- 1:30 PM** We arrive in **Centerville, Indiana at the Warm Glow Candle Outlet*** where you'll be able to shop the various candles they have on display.
- 2:30 PM** We board our coach and depart for **Grove City, Ohio** where we'll overnight.
- 5:00 PM** We arrive at the **Drury Inn & Suites in Grove City, Ohio*** for our first overnight stay. We'll enjoy Drury's **Kickback Program*** this evening here at the hotel for dinner.

Day #2 – Tuesday, May 19th:

Breakfast* is served here at the hotel before we check out and make our way to our next stop along the way in Stoystown, Pennsylvania. We'll make a stop at the



Flight 93 National Memorial for a self-guided tour*. This memorial honors the 40-passengers and crew of the United Airlines Flight 93 who died on September 11th, 2001, when their plane crashed in Shanksville, PA, after they fought back against the hijackers. The memorial is located on the crash site and includes a Visitor's Center, A Tower of Voices, a Wall of Names, and 40 Memorial Groves. Afterward, we depart for our hotel in Lancaster,

Pennsylvania, where we'll check in for the next 4 nights stay at the **Tru by Hilton Lancaster East Hotel***. Dinner is on your own tonight.

Day #3 – Wednesday, May 20th:

Breakfast* is served and then we depart for our preferred seating for a fantastic performance of **Joshua*** at the beautiful **Sight & Sound Theatre**.

Day #4 – Thursday, May 21st:

Breakfast* is served and then we're off to the **Amish Experience Theatre**. "Compelling" best describes the emotional story of "Jacob's Choice", old through the everyday lives of the fictional Fisher family, an Old Order Amish family of today. Shown on five different screens, witness young Jacob's struggle in choosing the Amish church, or leaving behind family & community for the allure of the modern world. Next, you'll enjoy an **Amish Country Homestead Tour***. Inside the Homestead, you'll learn of Amish traditions and practices, plain clothing and life without electricity from the grid. The one-room school is attached to the house and filled with authentic desks and furnishings from an actual Amish School. Then you'll ride back in time with an **Amish Buggy Ride*** before we enjoy an **Amish Farmlands Tour***. This tour takes you deep into the



heart of the oldest Amish community in the world where you'll marvel at some of the most beautiful farmland you'll ever set eyes upon. The tour covers topics such as Amish history & origins, population statistics and trends, farming practices, use & adaptation of technology, medical care, taxes and banking, education and vocation, courting and weddings and many more subjects. Lunch will be on your own today before our afternoon **Amish Artisan**

Tour*. You'll be taken to meet four Amish artisans, in their workshops where they make their merchandise. Meet the Artisan, See what they make and how they make it, Hear from them how they got started and ask questions about their

journey. Our day ends in an **Amish Home for a meal***. This is an all you care to eat family-style feast. We'll head back to the hotel following dinner.

Day #5 – Friday, May 22nd:

Breakfast* is included this morning before we depart for **Kitchen Kettle Village*** for a little more shopping and lunch on your own. This afternoon we'll enjoy a **tour & pretzel making at the Julius Sturgis Bakery***. The bakery was



founded in 1861 and is the first commercial pretzel bakery in America; and the Sturgis family is the oldest pretzel baking family in America. Learn how their old fashioned recipes and methods were established and how they're still used today! You'll tour the original pretzel bakery, get a hands-on lesson in pretzel twisting using a playdough mixture, observe the bakers twisting old fashioned soft pretzels by hand, and shop for delicious treats and souvenirs from the bakery store. Next, we'll do a **Group Wine Tasting* at Mount Hope Estate &**

Winery. Located in Northern Lancaster County, this winery has grown from a private residence to a flourishing historic estate featuring spectacular entertainment. Then this evening we'll enjoy a performance at the **Dutch Apple Dinner Theatre***. Show is yet to be determined. Following the show, we head back to the hotel for the evening.

Day # 6 – Saturday, May 23rd:

Breakfast* is served before we check out and depart for Mill Run, Pennsylvania. Upon arrival, we'll **tour Frank Lloyd Wright's Falling Water***. Falling Water is a very special house that is built over a water fall. Falling Water was built between 1936 & 1939 for the Kaufmann family. It instantly became famous and is located on the National Historic Landmark registry. While here you'll enjoy a **Box Lunch***. Following the tour, we make our way to Dublin, Ohio where we'll overnight. We'll stay at the **Drury Inn & Suites*** so you'll be able to enjoy their **Kickback Program*** for dinner.

Day #7 – Sunday, May 24th:

Breakfast* is served at the hotel before we check out.

8:30 AM We check out and depart for the **National Museum of the U.S. Air Force for a tour***. The museum is the world's largest and oldest military aviation museum and houses over 350 aerospace vehicles and missiles, including iconic aircraft like "Air Force One".

Noon It's time to depart for home making rest and meal stops along the way as needed. *Note: Don't forget to set your watches back an hour as we re-enter the Central Time Zone.*
