Day #1 – Thursday, October 1st:

Day #2 – Friday, October 2nd:

Breakfast* is served at the hotel before we check out and depart for our next overnight stop in Amarillo, Texas. We'll make rest and meal stops along the way as needed. We arrive at the **Holiday Inn Express Amarillo West*** for our overnight stay.

Day #3 – Saturday, October 3rd:

Enjoy Breakfast* before we check out and depart for Albuquerque, New Mexico. This afternoon, we'll check into Holiday Inn Express Old Town* for the next 4 nights. This evening you'll enjoy an Evening Session at the Balloon Fiesta*. The Balloon Glow happens when all the balloons fire their burners and light up at the same time. Probably the most spectacular single moment in all of Balloon Fiesta. Followed by the After Glow Fireworks, New Mexico's most spectacular fireworks display – now among Balloon Fiesta's most popular events. During the Balloon Fiesta, you'll enjoy a nice Dinner on a Private Outdoor Patio* located next to the launch field. Your upgraded ticket grants you access to seating in a comfortable outdoor patio next to the launch field where you can indulge in

hot food items, dessert and refreshments.

Day #4 – Sunday, October 4th:

Breakfast* is served at the hotel. This morning we'll tour* the Anerson Abruzzo Balloon Museum*. Set on the southern edge of Balloon Fiesta Park, the balloon museum is a focal point in the Balloon Fiesta, but its scope is much more broad. As the world's premier balloon museum facility dedicated to the art, culture, science, history, sport and spectacle of ballooning. The museum features one of the world's finest collections of ballooning equipment and memorabilia. Next, we'll enjoy the **Old Town** Plaza Tour* as you learn the secrets, sights, sounds, flavors, shops, products, photo opportunities, and all the unique things at Old Town. Lunch is on your own while here. Afternoon finds us visiting the Indian Pueblo Cultural Center for a tour*. The center is owned and operated by the 19 Indian Pueblos of New Mexico and is dedicated to the preservation and perpetuation of the Pueblo Indian Culture, History & Art. The center features daily dances, art markets, exhibitions, live entertainment, museums, native food and more. **Dinner*** is included this evening at a local restaurant.

Day #5 – Monday, October 5th:

This morning you'll enjoy the Morning Session at the Balloon Fiesta*.

It's an early morning today, starting before dawn at the Albuquerque Balloon Fiesta. The Dawn Patrol Show is choreographed inflation & launch set to music. Followed by the morning glow, Mass Ascension occurs when more than 500 Balloons from all over the world rise together in a harmonious lift off. **Breakfast*** is included this morning at the Balloon Fiesta. Next, you'll enjoy a **ride on the Sandia Peak** Aerial Tramway*, as it transports you above deep canyons and breathtaking terrain at a distance of 2.7 miles. See some of nature's



more dramatic beauty unfold before you! **Dinner*** is included this evening at a local restaurant. We head back to the hotel following dinner.



Day #6 – Tuesday, October 6th:

Breakfast* is included this morning at the hotel. This morning we'll travel north to Santa Fe via the Turquoise Trail. The Turquoise Trail National Scenic Byway encompasses 15,000 square miles in the heart of central new Mexico, linking Santa Fe & Albuquerque. The drive is approximately 50 miles along Hwy 14. Upon arrival we'll visit the world-renowned **Loretto Chapel***, famous for its miraculous floating staircase. You'll also visit the **Palace of the Governors and the Historic Santa Fe Square***. Originally constructed in the early 17th century as Spain's seat of government in the American Southwest, the Palace of the Governors chronicles the history of Santa Fe. An adobe structure, it is now the State's history museum and sits opposite the Santa Fe Plaza. The Loretto Chapel is a former Roman Catholic Church that is now used as a museum and wedding chapel. It is known for its unusual helix-shaped spiral staircase, that may have been created by carpenter "Frenchy" Rochas, however the Sisters of Loretto credit its construction to St. Joseph. Regardless, the story is as fascinating as the stairway is unique. Following our tours, we return to Albuquerque where your afternoon & evening are free and dinner is on your own.

Day #7 – Wednesday, October 7th:

Breakfast* is included before we check out and start our journey towards home. We'll make rest & meal stops en route to our destination in Clinton, Oklahoma. Upon arrival, we check into the **Hampton Inn and enjoy dinner at Lucille's Roadhouse*.**

Day #8 – Thursday, October 8th:

Breakfast* is included and then we check out and continue our journey towards home. We'll make rest & meal stops along the way as needed. Upon arrival in **Springfield**, **Missouri**, we check into the **Drury Inn & Suites***. **Dinner*** is included this evening at **Lambert's***.

Day #9 – Friday, October 9th:

Breakfast* is included.
We check out, board our coach and depart for home making necessary rest
& meal stops along the way.
