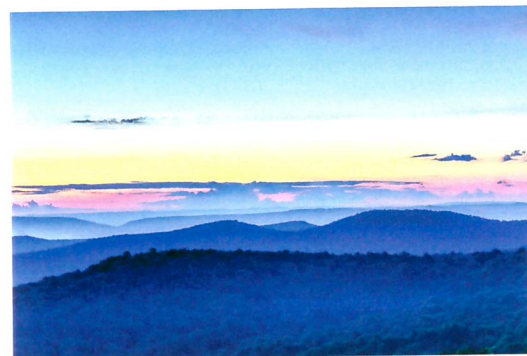

Stand beneath the dome of the U.S. Capitol, pause at the Lincoln Memorial, and honor the fallen at Arlington National Cemetery. In Philadelphia, explore Independence Hall, where both the Declaration of Independence and the U.S. Constitution were signed, and gaze upon the Liberty Bell, still echoing the call to freedom.

Visit **Gettysburg**, site of the largest battle ever fought on American soil and where Abraham Lincoln delivered his timeless Gettysburg Address. Amidst these historical treasures, enjoy the natural serenity of **Shenandoah National Park**. Drive along **Skyline Drive**, where the Blue Ridge Mountains stretch endlessly into the horizon, offering peaceful contrast to its stirring history. Tour the elegant country estates of two founding fathers—George Washington's **Mount Vernon**, perched above the Potomac River, and Thomas Jefferson's **Monticello**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site that reflects Jefferson's Enlightenment vision in both architecture and ideals. Journey to **Colonial Williamsburg**, a meticulously restored 18th-century town where costumed interpreters animate daily life in the years leading to the Revolution. Follow in the footsteps of patriots and presidents. From hallowed halls to quiet landscapes, from revolutionary sparks to civil reckoning, this unforgettable journey through America's Historic East honors the legacy of a nation – and the people whose courage and conviction continue to shape its future.

### DAY 1: FLIGHT TO PHILADELPHIA

Arrive in **Philadelphia** which in Greek translates to 'the city of brotherly love'. Meet your Tour Director and transfer to your hotel for an overnight stay. The evening is at leisure. Overnight: **Philadelphia**

### DAY 2: PHILADELPHIA - LANCASTER - AMISH COUNTRY - GETTYSBURG

Today, enjoy a Philadelphia City Tour to see the Most Historic Square Mile in America featuring Independence Hall and the Liberty Bell. See Independence Hall, the site where the United States Constitution was debated and adopted & the setting for the 1776 signing of the Declaration of Independence. Later, visit the Reading Terminal Market, Philadelphia's Market since 1893, and one of America's largest and oldest public markets. The market is housed in a National Historic Landmark building and offers an incredible selection of restaurants in addition to locally sourced food, baked goods, cheeses, confections and other gifts. This afternoon step back in time as you travel into the tranquil heart of Pennsylvania Amish Country where the horse and buggy remain the primary form of transportation and windmills dot the landscape. The Pennsylvania Amish of Lancaster County are America's oldest Amish settlement, and where thousands still live a centuries old 'lifestyle'. Visit an Amish Farm &

House to learn about their faith, culture, distinctive dress and way of life that forbids the use of electricity or telephones in the home. Enjoy a traditional Amish Family Style Dinner where the great food just keeps coming. Travel to Gettysburg to check into your hotel for a two-night stay. (B,D) Overnight: **Gettysburg**

### DAY 3: GETTYSBURG

Spend the day exploring Gettysburg where we delve into the devastation of a four-year civil war pitting North against South. Visit the Gettysburg National Military Park Museum and Visitor Center and learn about the National Park's efforts to preserve the battlefield. This experience supports the preservation and understanding of the heritage and lasting significance of Gettysburg. Join a local guide who will bring to life the events at Gettysburg that turned the tide of the Civil War. Cast your mind back to the pivotal yet tragic day on which Pickett led his charge at Gettysburg. Just four months later, the battlefield served as the backdrop for Abraham Lincoln's call for "a new birth of freedom" in his famed Gettysburg Address. Enjoy dinner this evening. (B,D) Overnight: **Gettysburg**

### DAY 4: GETTYSBURG - SHENANDOAH NATIONAL PARK - CHARLOTTESVILLE

This morning, we say goodbye to Gettysburg and journey through the beautiful rolling hills of the

Shenandoah National Park enroute to Charlottesville. Enjoy the natural serenity of Shenandoah National Park as you drive along Skyline Drive, where the Blue Ridge Mountains stretch endlessly into the horizon, offering peaceful contrast to its stirring history. Later arrive in Charlottesville for an overnight stay with the evening at leisure to relax and enjoy dinner on your own. (B) Overnight: **Charlottesville**

### DAY 5: CHARLOTTESVILLE - RICHMOND - MONTICELLO - WILLIAMSBURG

Visit Monticello, the neoclassical Italian estate where Jefferson once sought a quieter existence. Explore this neoclassical Italian-style estate where Thomas Jefferson, a key figure of the American Revolution and the third President of the United States, once lived. Stop in Virginia's capitol of Richmond and visit St John's Church, the very spot where George Washington and Thomas Jefferson were inspired by Patrick Henry's fiery "Give me liberty or give me death" speech. Later arrive in Williamsburg, founded in 1638 as Middle Plantation, and the former capital of the Commonwealth of Virginia. Check into your hotel for an overnight stay and enjoy dinner this evening. (B,D) Overnight: **Williamsburg**





#### DAY 6: COLONIAL WILLIAMSBURG - MT. VERNON - WASHINGTON DC

Today we step back in time and explore Colonial Williamsburg, once Britain's largest colony in the New World. See historical reenactors and artisans populate the streets and buildings, bringing 1770 to life. Chat with blacksmiths and soldiers, and perhaps even engage in some politicking with a costumed Federalist. Enjoy free time for lunch on your own and explore this iconic site and wander the cobblestone streets, explore the historic buildings, some leisure time on our own in nearby Merchant's Square. Next, drive to Alexandria Virginia to visit the Mt. Vernon Estate and Gardens, President George Washington's beautiful estate overlooking the Potomac River. The "Father of Our Country" called Mt. Vernon home for more than 45 years. Tour the house and gardens and visit the grave site of our first President. Later, arrive in Washington DC, the political heart of America. Check into your Washington DC hotel and unpack for a three-night stay. (B,D) Overnight: Washington DC

#### DAY 7: DC CITY TOUR - ARLINGTON - WHITE HOUSE VISITOR CENTER

After breakfast, visit Arlington National Cemetery, America's shrine to valor and sacrifice. Board the tram to see the John F. Kennedy and Robert Kennedy graves plus the Changing of the Guard at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. Then, stop at the Marine Corps Memorial (Iwo Jima Statue). This afternoon embark on a panoramic Washington DC city tour with a stop at The White House Visitor Center to learn about our Executive Mansion and the Presidential families that lived there. An opportunity to also view the film 'White House: Reflections from Within'. Today's city tour stops at our impressive Memorials: Jefferson, Franklin D. Roosevelt, M.L.K. Jr., and National WWII. Tonight, enjoy dinner with your fellow travelers. (B,D) Overnight: Washington DC

#### DAY 8: WASHINGTON DC AS YOU WISH - DC TWILIGHT ILLUMINATION TOUR

The day is free to relax or explore Washington DC on your own. Perhaps spend the day exploring and learning at the world-famous Smithsonian Institution Museums such as the Air & Space, Natural History, American History or Gallery of Art. Perhaps a visit to the incredible National Museum of African American History and Culture. This is the only national museum devoted exclusively to the documentation of African American life, history, and culture and houses over 40,000 fascinating artifacts. Tonight, enjoy a Farewell Dinner this evening followed by an included DC Twilight Illumination Tour of famous monuments. You'll be wowed by this illuminated overview of the nation's capital city at night! See the Capitol, the White House, the Jefferson Memorial, the Iwo Jima Marine Corps Memorial, the Kennedy Center and more. Always a major highlight to any visit to Washington DC.
