Day 1: Thursday, August 26, 2027 Bozeman, Montana - Tour Begins Welcome to Big Sky Country. Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel and take some time to unwind or start exploring this charming Western gateway at your own pace. Wander through downtown Bozeman, where historic storefronts, craft breweries, and mountain-inspired dining create the perfect introduction to the region's unique character. As traveler arrival times vary, no group activities or meals are planned. Tonight, settle in and get ready for an unforgettable adventure into the heart of America's first national park.

Day 2: Friday, August 27, 2027 Bozeman - Yellowstone National Park Today, immerse yourself in the iconic wonders of Yellowstone. Discover its legendary scenery, from forested valleys and roaming wildlife to mesmerizing geothermal marvels. As evening approaches, head to Roosevelt Corrals for an authentic Old West Dinner Cookout, where hearty fare and western hospitality await. Day 4: Sunday, August 29, 2027 Yellowstone National Park - Sun Valley, Idaho Bid farewell to Yellowstone as the journey winds through sweeping western scenery en route to Sun Valley, Idaho, a mountain resort with a storied past. Since its founding in the 1930s, the Sun Valley Resort has set the standard for alpine elegance, evolving into a legendary resort favored by generations of cultural icons and winter sport champions. This evening, gather for dinner at Sun Valley Resort, overlooking the famous outdoor ice rink once graced by Olympic legends. Surrounded by alpine elegance and fresh mountain air, the evening sets the tone for your stay in this legendary destination. (B, D)

Day 5: Monday, August 30, 2027 Sun Valley Discover the charm and heritage of Sun Valley during a locally guided history tour, learning how this mountain retreat became a playground for artists, athletes, and celebrities. In the afternoon, **it's your choice** — pick one activity or choose them all! Design your day at this iconic resort — lace up your skates at the historic ice rink **-OR-** enjoy a round of bowling **-OR-** catch a film at the Opera House **-OR-** or unwind with a game at the Sawtooth Putting Course. It's a delightful mix of leisure, history, and personal discovery. (B)

Day 6: Tuesday, August 31, 2027 Sun Valley - Boise

Travel from the mountains to Idaho's capital city, stopping at breathtaking Shoshone Falls, often called the "Niagara of the West." In Boise, explore a distinctive cultural legacy shaped by immigrants from the Pyrenees region of northern Spain and southern France with a visit to the Basque Museum, home to one of the largest Basque communities in the United States. Experience the thrill of a private Hells Canyon jetboat tour, cruising through North America's deepest river gorge while learning about its geology, wildlife, and frontier history. Later, deepen your understanding of

the region during an **Impact Moment** with a Nez Perce Cultural Experience that offers insight into the traditions and resilience of the Nez Perce people. Conclude your day in memorable fashion with a private dinner at a vineyard, featuring a wine tasting amid rolling vineyards and river views. *(B, L, D)*

Day 9: Friday, September 3, 2027 Lewiston - Spokane, Washington

Travel into Washington State en route to Spokane, where a guided city tour reveals historic districts, riverfront scenery, and architectural gems. Tonight, stay at the legendary Davenport Hotel, where timeless elegance and modern luxury define Spokane hospitality. Gather for a farewell dinner at the hotel's elegant restaurant as you reflect on the remarkable country and cultures explored along the way. *(B, D)*

Day 10: Saturday, September 4, 2027 Spokane - Tour Ends

Your journey through the American West comes to a close today as you depart Spokane. Reflect on the scenery, people, and unforgettable moments that defined this adventure — from geothermal wonders and canyon rivers to mountain towns and living traditions. Important Tour Information:

Book Now rates valid until Jan 26, 2027, valid on air inclusive packages only.

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 3. This means you're an on-the-go traveler. You don't want to miss a thing, so walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal. A moderately paced two-and-a-half-hour walking tour, covering several miles, hills, and uneven surfaces, is no problem for you. Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable, as is climbing into and out of various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.). You can climb three flights of stairs easily and handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. Expect some longer days with early mornings or late nights balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. This level is not a fit for travelers who require mobility assistance devices.

Travel with an average of 16 people (maximum of 24).

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at the time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

This tour does not require sustained walking or extended periods of standing. However, it includes high-altitude travel with 2 nights in Yellowstone National Park at approximately 8,000 feet (2,438 meters) in elevation. While most travel at higher elevations is by coach, we spend significant time above 8,000 feet in Yellowstone National Park and time above 5,000 feet (1,524 meters) at the Sun Valley Resort. High altitudes may not be suitable for some travelers; we suggest you consult your physician if you have any concerns.

To fully experience all that we have included on this tour, there will be 3 longer travel days with 4 hours or more of driving, including stops. These occur on the routes between Yellowstone and Sun Valley, Sun Valley and Boise, and Boise and Lewiston.

In addition, due to the sites visited, your tour schedule requires departures before 9:00 a.m. on both mornings in Yellowstone National Park, as well as an early departure for your jet boat tour in Lewiston.

Personal audio devices (headsets) are not included on this tour.

Your jetboat tour in Hells Canyon includes seats with back support and restroom facilities onboard. Stops are made every hour that include restrooms. The boats are covered and can be completely enclosed with over-sized see-through windows. Travelers should be comfortable stepping onto and off a boat several times during the tour. Jetboat tours traverse bumpy waterways at high speeds.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Single rate subject to change based on availability.

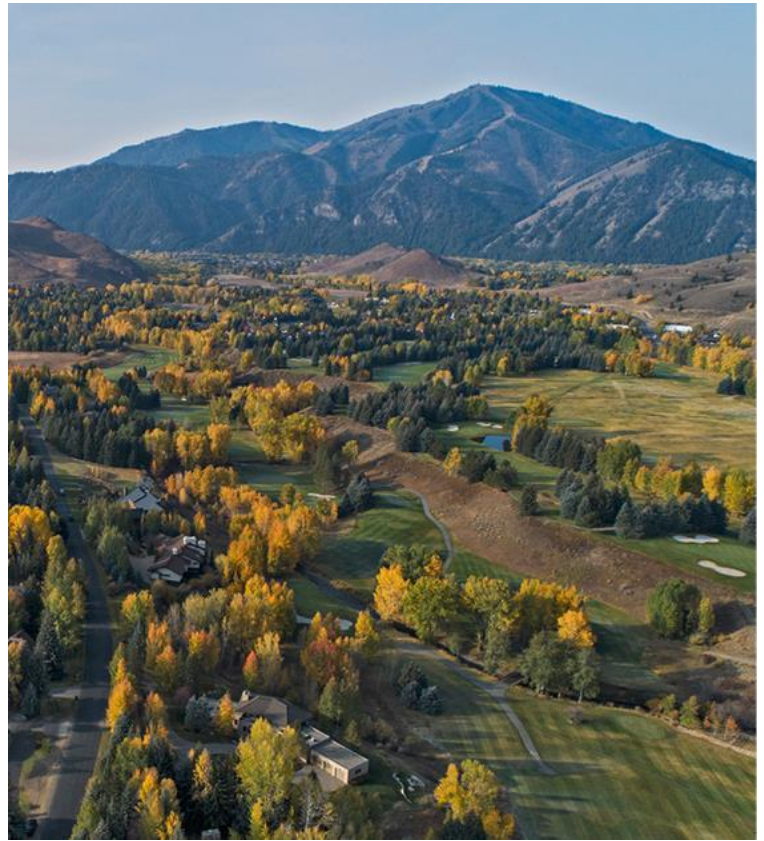
Our transfers will depart from Bozeman, Montana.

To complete your tour, we include round-trip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your own air, we are pleased to provide you the option of *purchasing* these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.

Our air travelers will arrive into the Bozeman Yellowstone International Airport.

For air-inclusive reservations, the name provided at time of booking must match your government-issued ID that will be used during travel. Name changes are subject to penalties.

Please be advised, many airlines do not provide advance seat assignments until check-in at the airport. Advance seating will be subject to the airline's terms and conditions.



Prepaid tipping is not available on our tours therefore payment of customary end-of-trip gratuities for your Tour Manager, driver, hotel housekeepers, and cruise ship waitstaff should be handled individually when applicable during the course of your tour.

Economy air rate and schedule are applicable for groups of 10 or more traveling on the same flights and dates.
